



ECP PERMISSION FOR SUNSCREEN, INSECT REPELLENT, OVER THE COUNTER CREAMS AND OINTMENTS

The Department of Early Education and Care requires parental permission for teachers to apply sunscreen, insect repellent, diaper cream, petroleum jelly and other non-prescription ointments which are not applied to open wounds, open rashes, or broken skin. Using the list below, parents should give permission only for the age appropriate items that they anticipate their child will need. Parents can discuss any special instructions regarding the application of these products, when they give the cream/ointment in the original container to their child's teacher.
